The deadline for completed applications to be received at the S hop is before **4pm on Friday, 17 May 2024**. The Committee will review all applications and advise the applicants of their awards by 29 May.

Grant cheques will be presented outside the S hop on Saturday, 15 June at 11:00am.

Please read the qualifying criteria below carefully before completing the form!

TCS Grant Funding - The IMPORTANT Qualifying Criteria

These criteria are applied by the TCS Management Committee when deciding whether an application should be supported and the level of award to be made.

The application is from or on behalf of a:

- Local/National charity which should provide support to our local community of Tibberton and Cherrington.
- Local event which benefits the local community of Tibberton and Cherrington and/or further generates funds for local/national charities.
- Local organisation which benefits the local community of Tibberton and Cherrington
 - With other support, to obtain beneficial assets for the organisation, but is...
 - Ideally not for running costs, and is...
 - Not retrospective [unless by prior agreement from TCS Management Committee].
- New local amenity, or for an enhancement to an existing one, which benefits the local community of Tibberton and Cherrington.

Depending on the number of applications received and the limit on the 'donations pot' the amount of each award agreed by the Committee may differ from the amount applied for, thus enabling as many applications which meet the above criteria as possible to receive some funding. Priority consideration will be given to new applicants.
